



Marshal Roster Policy

The Adelaide Hills Veterans Cycling Club will commence a roster system for marshalling effective from 19th April 2009. This was announced at the beginning of this year. We will roster up to a maximum of three (3) SAPOL trained Traffic Marshals for each of our events according to the needs of each course. This will maintain our Duty of Care to provide a safe environment for our member riders, associate members, spectators and other road users.

We will roster all registered and SA Police trained registered primary club riding members (those who have paid their full club fees and SAVCC fees through the club) in alphabetical order. Rostered marshals are free to nominate a replacement. We are hopeful that as many riders as possible will nominate replacements that can be trained and form a basis for marshals in future years. Only a SA Police trained Traffic Marshal can be accepted as a nominated replacement and they must be either a full/associate member of the AHVCC in order to be covered by insurance for marshalling at events.

Rostered marshals who cannot nominate a replacement for the AHVCC Club Consistency Award Series will not be penalised and will receive ten (10) points if they are rostered in those events. We are making all efforts not to have to roster riders for Club Championship and Open Events that we are hosting. Committee members will attempt to cover these events with additional assistance if required.

If a rostered rider does not nominate a replacement or turn up for marshalling duties that rider will be suspended from riding in AHVCC, SAVCC, open events and associated clubs for four (4) weeks. If a rider is suspended a letter will be forwarded to clubs and via the SAVCC by club delegate.

Rostered riders will be detailed on the Events Calendar on the club web site against each event. A copy of the roster will be available at all club riding events. If you or your nominated replacement has a problem being rostered for a particular event or if you have an emergency in the 24 hours before the event, please contact Dave Barrett on 0449 190120 or John Bleakley on 0400 590941 as a matter of priority in order that we can organise Traffic Marshal cover for the event.
